## Bachelor of Arts Degree 4-Year Psychology Major

The four-year Bachelor of Arts Degree, offered in co-operation with Athabasca University, allows students to complete a degree at Blue Quills First Nations College by majoring in various areas of study.

The 120 credit B.A. Program provides students with a broad, flexible education that encourages development, understanding and dissemination of knowledge, critical thinking, and building of these abilities. The B.A. Program also allows students to fully prepare for most graduate studies.

Although students may change majors, a major must be selected when enrolling in the B.A. Program. A number of majors are available through Athabasca University including Canadian Studies, Women's Issues, Sociology and Psychology, however the only major available, at the present time, here at Blue Quills College is the **Psychology Major**.

**General requirements for the B.A. Degree include 120 credits with minimum credits required being:**

1. 75 credits at the senior level (300 & 400 level) including 18 credits at the 400 level; 45 in the Major ( Minimum senior level credits in major, including a Minimum of 12 credits at the 400 level)
2. 96 credits of Arts and Social Science courses
3. 18 credits of Humanities courses
4. 18 credits of Social Sciences courses
5. 6 credits of Science courses

A minimum of 30 credits must be completed with Athabasca University to obtain the degree. The student must also complete a minimum of 30 credits of senior level courses in the selected major.

Maximum Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition credits- 9  
\*A maximum of 39 PLAR credits are allowed if you declare a Labour Studies Major.

**Admission Requirements:**

Candidates are required to satisfactorily complete the Skills Appraisal Testing.
